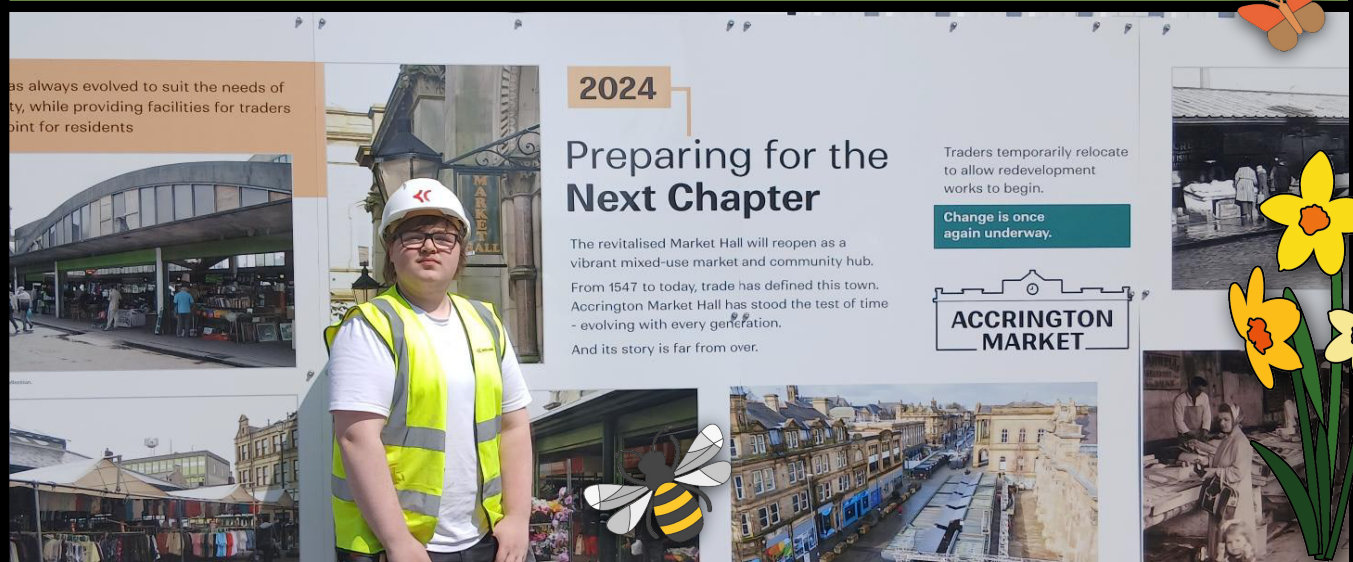

Throughout construction, first and second-year carpentry and joinery students have spent time on site gaining hands-on experience and developing their practical skills.

As Accrington Market nears completion, local businesses are delivering the specialist fit-out work that will bring the venue to life. Things are beginning to take shape at **Accrington Market** now that the steelwork for the market stalls has been installed, making it much easier to picture the finished product. We have also switched to a new power supply and completed decorative and fire protection works. Partitioning, steelwork and electrical works remain ongoing.
